7. **MOTION - CONSIDERATION OF THE SUPPLEMENTARY ESTIMATES II FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR 2022/2023 (General Debate)**

Motion made in an amended form and Question proposed:-

THAT, this House **adopts** the Report of the Budget and Appropriations Committee on the Second Supplementary Estimates for the Financial Year 2022/2023, *laid on the Table of the House on Tuesday, 20th June 2023*, and pursuant to the provisions of Article 223 of the Constitution and Standing Order 243 –

- (i) **approves an increment** of the total recurrent expenditure for Financial Year 2022/2023 by **Ksh.9,515,817,997** in respect of the Votes as contained in the Schedule;
- (ii) **approves a decrease** of the total capital expenditure for Financial Year 2022/2023 by **Ksh. 34,977,926,251** in respect of the Votes as contained in the Schedule;
- (iii) **approves an overall decrease** in the total budget for Financial Year 2022/2023 by **Ksh. 25,462,108,254** in respect of the Votes as contained in the Schedule; and
- (iv) **resolves that** the Schedule forms the basis for the introduction of the Supplementary Appropriation (No. 2) Bill, 2023; subject to a reduction of Ksh. 189,000,000 from Vote 1053 State Department for Foreign Affairs and an increment of Ksh. 189,000,000 under Vote 1052 Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

And thereupon, Question put and agreed to.

Rising in his place on a Point of Order pursuant to Standing Order 95, the Member for Kilifi North (Hon. Baya Yaa) claimed to move that “The Mover be now called upon to reply”; And the Speaker acceding to the claim;

And thereupon, Question put and negatived;

Debate on the Bill resumed;

Rising in her place on a Point of Order pursuant to Standing Order 95, the Member for Dagoretti North (Hon. Beatrice Elachi) claimed to move that “The Mover be now called upon to reply”; and the Speaker acceded to the claim;

And thereupon, Question put and agreed to.

Question put and agreed to.

Bill read a Second Time and committed to the Committee of the Whole House.

9. **THE EQUALIZATION FUND APPROPRIATION BILL (SENATE BILL NO. 3 OF 2023)**

Motion made and Question proposed;

THAT, the Equalization Fund Appropriation Bill (Senate Bill No. 3 of 2023) be now read a Second Time;

Debate arising;

Rising in his place on a Point of Order pursuant to Standing Order 97, the Member for Kilifi North (Hon. Baya Yaa) claimed to move that “each speech on the debate on the Bill shall be limited to a maximum of three (3) minutes for any Member speaking”;

And the Speaker acceded to the claim;

And thereupon, Question put and agreed to.

Debate on the Bill resumed;

Rising in his place on a Point of Order pursuant to Standing Order 95, the Member for Ruiru (Hon. Simon Kingara) claimed to move that “The Mover be now called upon to reply”;
And the Speaker acceded to the claim;

And thereupon, Question put and agreed to.

Question put and agreed to.

Bill read a Second Time and committed to the Committee of the Whole House.
